

Badges and conference passes

Building access

Secretariat Rooms S-2727 & S-2726 (27th floor) in the UN Secretariat Building are located at The United Nations Headquarters on First Avenue between 42nd and 46th Streets.

For access to Secretariat Room S-2727/2726, you may access the Secretariat Building via 42^{nd} Street and First Avenue if you hold a valid UNLP or a New York UN Ground pass (staff members only).

If you do not hold a valid UNLP or New York staff Ground Pass, you can pick up your temporary pass at the following places and time slots. Please enter the United Nations premises through the Visitor's Entrance located on First Avenue, between 45th and 46th Streets (via the security tent). A valid photo ID will be required (e.g. passport).

Temporary pass pick-up:

- 8:30am to 9am, Monday to Wednesday, 9-11 March, outside of the UN Visitors' Entrance gate (1st Avenue between 45th and 46th street) since the UN does not open to the public until 9am. We will have a UNEG sign with us.
- **2:30pm to 3pm, Monday, 9 March, Ford Foundation lobby**, 320 East 43rd St. (between 1st & 2nd Aves)

The **Ford Foundation** is located at 320 East 43rd Street (bet 1st & 2nd Aves). The HLE & Chair's Reception will take place there. We will have a registration table in the lobby of the Ford Foundation.

The **UNICEF House** is located at Three United Nations Plaza, 44th Street (between 1st and 2nd Avenues). If you do not have a New York UN Ground pass, please get a temporary pass at the front desk in the lobby of the UNICEF House - we already sent your names to the UNICEF security.
