Collecting of badges

Tables will be made available outside the main meeting room (**Board Room A, 2nd floor, M-building**) for those who wish to share relevant publications or promotional material.


Location of the meetings

Within the VIC, all meetings will take place in **the M-building**. (See Annex 2 for all maps of the VIC premises and the various floors of the M-building.)

- The **EPE**'s main plenary sessions will be hosted in **Board Room A** (**2nd floor**); and breakout sessions will be held in M5, MOE03, MOE05, MOE07 and MOE100 (ground floor).
- The **HLE** will be hosted in **Board Room A** (2nd floor).
- The **AGM**'s main plenary sessions will be held in room **M2** (1st floor).

Final room details will be confirmed on the first days of the EPE and AGM plenary sessions.

Room MOE12 (ground floor) will further host a Secretariat for the Evaluation Week, with representatives of the host agencies available to provide information and support.



Lunches and coffee breaks

A lost and found office further operates in room F0E21. Participants are reminded not to leave briefcases or any valuable items unattended in conference rooms.


Travel agent

From the airport to the VIC or the city center:




"Heiligenstadt", and from there take bus no. 38A towards "Kahlenberg" and get off at " Armbrustergasse"; then walk up the street 20 meters until

you reach Arnbrustergasse to the right.



ANNEX 2: Maps of the VIC premises and M-building floors


VIC general view with M-building



M-Building - Ground floor




M-Building - First floor


