# High-level political forum on sustainable development (HLPF)

#### HLPF has a "central role in overseeing a network of follow-up and review processes at the global level" (2030 Agenda paragraph 82)

#### Forum is also expected to:

- ✓ enhance the integration of the three dimensions of sustainable development
- ✓ provide political leadership, guidance and recommendations on implementation and follow-up
- $\checkmark$  address new and emerging issues

### **2017 HLPF in numbers**



\* Thematic reviews of progress on the SDGs including cross-cutting issues – in line with GA resolution 70/1

\* Voluntary national reviews (VNRs) - regular reviews, in line with GA resolutions 67/290, 70/1 and 70/299

### **2018 High-Level Political Forum**

- The 2018 session will take place in July at UN Headquarters in New York
- The theme is "Transformation towards sustainable and resilient societies"
- 48 countries will present their voluntary national reviews

country driven reviews of progress at national and subnational levels, involving ministerial and other relevant high-level participants, with relevant UN and other partners


#### • Learning experience:
