- An advanced degree in education or social sciences;

- Good knowledge of current debates around education policy and teacher development in development contexts;
- Good knowledge of the UN system and international organizations;
- Fluency in written and spoken English;
- Knowledge of the roles and mandate of UNESCO and of its Education Programme;
- Knowledge of gender approaches in evaluation.
